IN THE FALL of 2019 three teenagers from Frayser, a suburb of Memphis, Tennessee made national and international news. This time it was not due to misdeeds or outrageous behavior such as is often chosen and highlighted by news outlets. These three formed a friendship that has warmed the hearts of millions. We celebrate Micheal Todd, Kristopher Graham and Antwain Garrett.

All three are students from Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. College Preparatory High School. Micheal had become the target of derision and had received a lot of verbal abuse due to wearing the same clothes to school for several days. Kristopher was among those who teased Micheal. His conscience began to nag at him that what he had participated in must have been devastating to Micheal. He confessed his regret to Antwain and together they devised a plan to reach out in kindness and acceptance to Micheal and make him a peace offering, to surprise Micheal with brand new clothes. The three have been friends since that day.

Unbeknownst to them a video of their simple act of kindness was posted on social media. The video has been viewed over 17 million times. Among those who viewed it was Ellen DeGeneres who invited the three to her show and surprised them with an appearance by Will Smith who gave them all some new clothes and promised to provide New Balance shoes for all the students at MLK, Jr. Prep. Their acts of humility, bravery and kindness have not gone unnoticed by the world.
